## Liturgy, Prayer and Worship.

Opportunities are provided for each member of the school community to take part in prayer and worship.

- The school day begins with an act of collective worship, either in the form of a classroom prayer or a whole school assembly.
- Mass is celebrated on particular feast days and on various occasions throughout the school year (see calendar).
- During the liturgical year, the main feasts and celebrations are observed. These include Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter.
- Pupils are able to participate in the Mass in various ways (reading, serving, offertory etc).
- Pupils occasionally attend a reflection in the chapel as part of RS lessons. We are currently reviewing the practice of previous years where there were regular weekly reflections in the chapel led by a senior member of staff.
